





AFS is proud to announce the opening of the AFS diaper pantry. We have disposable diapers, cloth diapers, wipes, pullups, adult incontinence and feminine hygiene needs.

Who Can Receive Diapers?

Any individual who needs diapers, wipes, or feminine or adult hygiene products is eligible. There is NO application process and AFS does not discriminate based on race, ethnicity, class, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, or age.

What You Can Get

Parents of children ages 3 and under (or a child with special needs) will receive 30 diapers and 1 package of wipes OR 20 pullups and 1 package of wipes. Feminine hygiene or adult diapers; participants will receive 30 feminine/adult sanitary products.

Diapers will be disbursed the last Wednesday of every month from 1:30-5:30 pm at 403 S. Alaska St. Palmer, AK


